- All Junior memberships to include free parent and grandparent golf on Templar course when playing with the Junior member.

Full Explanation of Swanston 2016 Golf Membership Categories -
All Ages Calculated on 1st March Each Season.

- 1 **'FULL'** members receive unlimited play on both courses and practice facilities and a 25% discount on range balls, 14 days advanced booking of tee times and 12 half price guest tickets each year.
- 2 **'5-DAY'** Can play on both courses on weekdays only however they may also play at weekends paying the Guest rate if times are available from 14.30 onwards – 13 days advanced booking of tee times,
- 3 **'SENIOR'** *Senior' members' reduced fees available to those that have achieved the age of 65 before 1st March and have to have been a Full member for a minimum of 5 full seasons. Senior members receive 13 days advanced booking of tee times, unlimited play on both courses and practice facilities. There are many 'Seniors' competitions throughout the year that only require members to be 50 or 55 on the date of the competition; this is a different qualification to membership discount. Anyone over the age of 65 wishing to take out a new Senior membership will be charged 85% of the Clubs Full Membership fees*
- 4 **'FAMILY 1'** although designed for two-golfing parent families you can use this category for any two adult memberships in the same family. All Family Junior and Youth (up to and including aged 25) memberships are included. 14 days advanced booking of tee times
- 5 **'FAMILY-2'** membership (benefits are same as above) and is designed for 1 adult membership. 14 days advanced booking of tee times
- 6 **'YOUTH 1 & 2'** discounted rates are available for ages 18 to 29 inclusive offering unlimited golf with 13 days weeks advanced online booking
- 7 **'JUNIOR'** member categories are split into 3 age groups. All parents and grandparents of Juniors play for free on the Templar course when with their Junior member Any Junior with a handicap of 18 or better can play in adult medals, but not win the trophy or sweeps; play must be with at least one non Junior member No Direct Debit option on this category. All Juniors should gain a handicap of 24 or better before playing on the 'Swanston' 18-hole course unaccompanied by an adult.
- 8 **'TEMPLAR'** the shortcourse membership allows players unlimited use of the Templar course and practice facilities, participation in the Templar medals and annual maintenance of a handicap and online 3 week advanced tee booking. Play on the 18 hole course is now allowed from 14.30 – 16.00 Monday – Friday and 14.30 onwards at weekends for the cost of a Guest ticket
- 9 **'COUNTRY/OVERSEAS'** Qualification comes from your main place of residence being outwith 50 miles of Swanston. Membership includes unrestricted access to both courses.
- 10 **'ARMED SERVICES'** A reduced annual membership of Swanston. Direct Debit option now available in 2nd and subsequent years. 13 days weeks advanced online booking
- 11 **'LIMITED PLAY'** cheaper membership limited to 20 rounds a year, a maximum of 4 unused rounds may be carried forward to the following year. It does include handicap maintenance and participation in midweek and weekend club medals/competitions, except the Club Championship Match Play stages. 13 days weeks advanced online booking

LOCKERS

All locker dues must be paid in full in before 1st March.

PAYMENT BY DIRECT DEBIT

Annual fees over £200 may be paid interest free by Direct Debit, a payment by cash, cheque, debit or credit card is required for the first 2 installments with the remaining 10 being paid by Direct Debit.

The member agrees to pay a full 12 payments - If the member decides to leave or resign before 12 payments have been paid the member must pay the full annual fee agreed when joining. The Club does not refund any monies to those members that pay their annual fees "all up front" who leave during the following 12 months. The Club will pursue all defaulters in the interests of itself and all other Club members
